That means helping constituents on a variety of casework issues from passports to benefit claims to reporting highway maintenance problems, raising issues in Parliament like the finances of Derby County FC and the impact of energy prices on the haulage industry, and continuing to progress key projects which will make a life changing difference to residents across our local communities.

Whether that's campaigning for post-16 education in the Bolsover constituency, tackling crime and anti-social behaviour, supporting our NHS, working with local schools to ensure every child reaches their full potential, attracting more skilled and high-paid jobs to our region, fighting inappropriate housing developments, regenerating our town centres or working to deliver essential transport and infrastructure projects.

Parliament has now broken-up for the Summer Recess – meaning I will be out and about across the constituency for the next 5-6 weeks delivering leaflets to update you on my work locally and launching surveys to get your views on what should be prioritised in your area. It is great to be able to escape Westminster and get back to doing what I love best - being out in the constituency, progressing my campaigns, visiting amazing organisations, and chatting with residents.
