Mark Works to Improve Longstanding Junction 28 Issues

For decades junction 28 has struggled to cope with the high volume of traffic that passes through it every day. Long queues backing up onto the M1 and into South Normanton cause significant delays. The junction is a vital part of the region's infrastructure, being the main gateway into South Normanton, Pinxton, Mansfield and Sutton in Ashfield.

Mark has been working with the leader of Bolsover District Council to fight for improvements to the junction. Recently both wrote joint a letter to Highways England to request funding to start making improvements on the junction.
